Types of Utility Knives

Utility knives differ in their opening and closing mechanisms as well as blade positioning.

Fixed

These knives have fixed blades that remain in place. Featuring a sturdy handle, the fixed blade utility knife is ideal for cutting heavy-duty materials cleanly and precisely. Moreover, this variant does not suffer from the blade-wiggling issue associated with retractable knives.

A fixed blade utility knife, on the other hand, remains erect, making it unsafe to carry around every day. You can cut carpets and other rugged materials with this tool without having to replace the blades constantly.

Retractable

In retractable utility knives, the blade is pushed outward by a sliding mechanism. Blade depth can easily be controlled with retractable knives. Blade tips are only pushed out for smaller and precision cuts. To make longer cuts more efficient, the user slides out a large chunk of the blade.

Blades can be replaced on retractable knives. However, it depends on the manufacturer of the product that how the replacement mechanism works. Changing the blade is as easy as a flick of a button with the quick-release mechanism.

Folding

The thin handle notch conceals the long blade of folding utility knives. Folding knives have blades that snap to the side, as opposed to retractable blades that slide upward. There are no injuries caused by this type of utility knife, and it is extremely safe to use.

Folding knives are popular because of their ease of use, compact size, and safety features. Folding knives are usually smaller than retractable knives, so they can easily be hung on a hook or carried in a pocket. Folding knives offer exceptional strength and cutting efficiency.

Breakaway

Breakaway utility knives are also called snap-off blades. A retractable utility knife is similar in design to this type, but the blade replacement mechanism differs entirely. Once the blade wears off, you can remove it from the breakaway utility knife. You can also snap these blades off several times to reveal a new one because they are longer in length.

Handle

In order to enhance the usability of your folding or retractable utility knife, the handle is an important component. Wooden, fiberglass, and metal handles are more durable than plastic ones. Make sure the utility knife's handle is contoured, so your hands are not awkwardly strained.

Proper grip

A utility's grip is usually determined by its material, texture, and shape. The outer handle of some utility knives has a rubberized surface to prevent slippage and make gripping easier. While cutting, grooves or textured surfaces also help maintain a stable grip.

Quality & value

A great selection of utility knives is available at a reasonable price. Make sure, however, that the material is of good quality and will last a long time before making an investment in such a tool. Buying a cheap knife with a thin blade and plastic material won't last through the first few cuts, for example. Make sure to choose a utility knife manufactured by a trusted brand that provides long-lasting durability and a sturdy blade.

Pocketing

In the pocketing metric, each product is measured by its ability to fit inside the pockets of work pants and, more specifically, the front and thigh pockets. The products are also tested to see how well they stay in the pocket. We check the tool's clip for fit over bulky denim seams if it has one.

Despite a well-thought-out design, the manufacturing of the knife could be improved. The blade carriage, for example, has some play in the moving parts. In addition, the tolerance on the handle closure is larger than desired. A blade with fewer moving parts might be a better choice if you plan to use it frequently and for heavy work. The model will be a wonderful tool for most non-professional tasks.

Gerber's EAB Lite Pocket Knife is a great all-around utility knife because of its compact size, durability, and innovative design. You can fold the Gerber knife out by pulling the top of the blade section. This product is made of brushed stainless steel with a smooth surface.

This knife has a firmly locked open blade and no side-to-side play. Without a hitch, it cuts right through plastic zip ties, blister packs, cardboard, and tape. The handle is made entirely of steel, and Gerber has added a blade guard in front of the handle, which should be helpful to a user with large hands. In terms of quality, this utility knife is comparable to those of high-end pocket knives.

With its extended length of 5.1 inches and a weight of 2.5 ounces, this Gerber model is compact and lightweight. It measures just 2.8 inches when folded. To change the blade, you will need a flat-head screwdriver.

4. Klein Tools 44133 Heavy Duty Utility Knife

It features solid construction and plenty of space for a secure grip, making it an excellent pocket knife. A spring lock secures the blade when the tool is in the open position, much like a standard pocket knife. This feature is particularly useful because it provides users with leverage similar to that of non-folding knives without the risk of an unexpected closure. Even when squatting or high-stepping, the knife will remain in place with its stiff pocket clip when folded up.

There are a few shortcomings to this model despite its sturdy construction and secure pocket clip. Firstly, unfolding the knife with one hand is quite difficult, though not impossible. If you try to close it without using two hands, it can be extremely difficult – bordering on danger. Lastly, there is no onboard storage for blades. This issue is counterbalanced by a simple and effective blade swiping system. Considering the price and quality, this is a very good knife.

With the right utility knife, you can get all the cutting power you need without spending a lot of money. Despite its simplicity, the Pacific Handy Cutter Utility Knife is both functional and safe. The handle is made of durable molded plastic, and the adjustable blade is controlled by a side slide.

This knife comes with a metal thumb shield near the blade's point that lets you choke up on it without risking cutting your thumb. Shields aren't necessary for all cutting tasks, but when cutting in straight lines, they will help you improve precision control by allowing your hand to slide forward.

Pacific Handy Cutter measures 5.75 inches and weighs 1.76 ounces. You can access the extra blade space by inserting a fingernail into the slot along the back edge and pulling upward. Retracting the blade is a bit of a hassle since it sticks out far enough for the user to cut a finger if they are not careful enough. It is possible to access and change blades by pressing a button at the bottom of the knife.
