Industrial Vacuum Cleaners Buying Guide

Type

One of the most important decisions you will have to make is what type of vacuum to buy. It can be obvious in some cases – for instance, if you need to clean up liquids, you will need a wet and dry vacuum. In general, cylinder vacuums are a good choice if you are looking for a versatile vacuum for dry cleaning. The upright vacuum cleaner is less convenient but excels at cleaning large areas quickly.

Upright Commercial Vacuums

There are only a few things that set these apart from their residential counterparts. There is a possibility for commercial upright vacuums to be slightly larger than you might expect from their large capacities. There will, of course, be exceptions to this rule.

Compared to standard vacuums, commercial vacuums have three prongs, and their cables are longer. Standard vacuums have two prongs. Commercial vacuums use more electricity, so their structure reflects this.

Although they have bigger brushes, they come with fewer attachments than residential vacuums, even if your new model comes with only the basics at the start.

Backpack Vacuums

Although backpack vacuums aren't very popular in homes, they're extremely versatile. This type of vacuum is carried on your back, so it can be moved more easily, and it's more versatile.

These vacuums must be lightweight since you wear them. Usually, they are multi-surface vacuums with a variety of attachments. Their suction is stronger, and their capacity is higher than that of residential backpack vacuums.

The machines are easy to transport and won't block your path. They provide users with more power and reach, and they can be useful for cleaning large spaces.

Canister Vacuums

Compared to upright vacuums, canisters are more versatile, so they're more popular for residential cleaning. Commercial cleaning doesn't use canisters as often. When you use canisters, you don't have to carry the whole machine with you. As a result of their design, cleaning them is less laborious.

The best thing about canister vacuums is their accessory capacity. Most come with standard add-ons, so you save money.

Filtration

When vacuuming hazardous dust, make sure the filter you use is safe to use with this type of material and make sure you take the necessary precautions.

Suction Power

While most industrial vacuums have strong suction, it is still a crucial consideration. The stronger a machine's suction, the better able it is to pick up dirt, dust, and other debris from carpets. Having a higher wattage does not always mean that it has more suction. More suction also allows a vacuum to pick up larger debris.

Durability

An industrial vacuum must be durable, even though it seems obvious. This is especially true if it will be used on a daily basis by your business. Domestic vacuums do not last long when used for heavy-duty tasks. Additionally, a durable vacuum should be able to clean up larger debris.

Noise Level

There is an often overlooked factor to consider when selecting a machine: its noise level. This might not be an issue for nighttime cleaning in an office. You should consider a quiet operation if you are going to clean during the daytime or if customers will be present during the cleaning process.

Price

While our top picks are expensive, there are some excellent models available for less than £100. If you're on a tight budget, a good vacuum can be found at a reasonable price.

Capacity

Often, domestic vacuums have very small dust canisters. Cordless vacuums often come with dust canisters that are less than 0.5 liters in volume. For home cleaning, this is fine, but for commercial cleaning, you'll have to empty the machine repeatedly.

1. Henry NRV 240-11 Dry Vacuum Cleaner

It's easy to see why Numatic is so popular among industrial and commercial users. Despite having a lower wattage than previous Henry vacuums, the vacuum is powerful and seals in dust well. Even though the vacuum has a lower wattage than previous Henry vacuums, it does not lose suction.

The machine does have a few drawbacks, such as the need to buy replacement bags, as well as being difficult to use in tight spaces. You may also have to be careful when it gets stuck, so it doesn't tip over.

Although the Numatic NRV 240-11 has these shortcomings, it is an excellent commercial vacuum. It is powerful and has a wide cleaning radius, making it ideal for industrial or commercial use. As opposed to many other wet and dry vacuum cleaners, the Sealey PC200SD is compact, nimble, and quiet. Its versatility is what made us conclude that Sealey's stainless steel vacuum might be one of the best wet and dry industrial vacuums.

It has a handy blower feature that can even clear clogged drains! Businesses with a lot of cleaning needs will appreciate the huge capacity of the dust canister of 20 liters.

This vacuum's powerful 1,250-watt motor is responsible for its strong suction. Foam filters can also be easily removed and washed if you want to ensure their cleanliness. Simply tip the dust container of the vacuum, and you can empty it easily. Additionally, you can use an extendable telescopic tube to clean above-floor areas.

By home standards, this vacuum isn't lightweight, but it's almost lightweight for businesses! The vacuum should also offer businesses the option of shampooing carpets and delivering comprehensive cleaning. A bagless design eliminates ongoing costs associated with replacement bags! Business owners will appreciate the compact size, powerful suction, and large dust and spill capacity of this vacuum cleaner!

However, a 4.5-meter power cord is a bit disconcerting!

4. SEBO BS360 Upright Commercial Vacuum Cleaner

- With this machine, the flat surface can be cleaned.

Cons

- It can be a bit cumbersome to use the SEBO.
- It can take some time to get used to the larger upright if you're used to a domestic upright.
- A longer hose would also be useful.

While the majority of commercial vacuum cleaners are cylinder models owing to their large capacities and versatility, there are some excellent upright models as well, such as the SEBO BS360.

Firstly, let us note that the BS36 is now EU-compliant. It's the same model but with a motor that produces 890W rather than the 1000W of previous versions. The suction power appears to have been unaffected by this.

A key feature of the BS360 is the larger cleaning head (36cm), which makes it stand out from domestic upright vacuums. This, combined with its twin-motor for excellent suction, allows it to cover a large area in a short amount of time. It's also built to last, just like other industrial vacuums.

With the BS360, you can clean beneath furniture, quickly clean blockages, and get underneath radiators with the floorhead's shape.

Despite the larger floorhead, the SEBO has the disadvantage of being somewhat challenging to use. The design is helpful when cleaning around furniture, but if you're used to a domestic upright, you might need some practice.

You could use the SEBO BS360 as a commercial upright vacuum if you need it. In addition to being powerful, the BS360 offers a unique floorhead that allows it to clean in tricky areas. Our favorite thing about the BS360 is its practicality, which is why we recommend it.

5. i.Force 1400W Bagless Vacuum

This i.Force vacuum is an excellent choice if you are looking for a massive, wet and dry vacuum for your workplace. The best thing about this 60-liter vacuum is its low price, which will keep costs down and keep your bottom line intact.

The vacuum features a powerful suction system as well as HEPA filtration. The foam filters are washable, which makes cleaning it a breeze. Rust will be kept at bay by the stainless steel body!

If you need to tidy up your yard or unclog drains, a blower function may be exactly what you need!

Given that the vacuum is nearly 15 kilos in weight, it is nice to have rolling wheels! The length of a 5-meter power cord makes cleaning large spaces, such as warehouse floors, difficult.

Its performance on plush carpets with thick carpet fibers was one area where you may encounter some difficulties. This industrial vacuum offers great value for money, has good filtration, and provides great suction.

6. MAXBLAST Industrial Vacuum 80L Cleaner

Featuring an 80-liter capacity and a powerful 3000W motor, the Maxblast 10678 is one of the most powerful vacuums on this list, making it an excellent choice for businesses that want a powerful vacuum cleaner.

Due to the Maxblast's design for commercial and industrial use, it's a highly durable model that emphasizes practical cleaning. It's easy to use, features a hinged lid for easy emptying, and is easy to move around.

Besides its basic floor tool, the Maxblast also includes two additional tools (bristle and crevice nozzle), as well as a cloth filter (but it isn't suitable for hazardous materials).

This commercial vacuum has a few drawbacks. This vacuum weighs 28 kg, making it the heaviest and largest vacuum we've reviewed, although this is understandable due to its 80-liter capacity. Additionally, we would have preferred a longer power cord and hose.

This powerful wet and dry vacuum is designed for heavy-duty cleaning jobs. In summary, although it's heavy and bulky, it's ideal for cleaning jobs that other vacuum cleaners cannot handle.

There are also 30-liter, 50-liter, and 60-liter models of Maxblast's industrial vacuum cleaners available. These models are lighter, but the motors are less powerful.
