Best Grease Gun—Buying Guide

There are various factors to consider while selecting the best grease gun. A good option generally spreads the grease accurately and rapidly, without making a mess. Some of the most important criteria to consider while shopping for the best grease gun are listed below.

1) Pressure Rating

There should be enough pressure for the grease gun to disperse the grease properly. These guns are available in a variety of pressure levels ranging from 3000 PSI to 10,000 PSI. A gun with a low PSI does not apply enough grease to large equipment, but a gun with a high PSI may harm smaller equipment.

2) Loading Options

The grease can be loaded in one of three ways: bulking, cartridge, or suction. The cartridge is the simplest and most costly method of loading the grease. Suction is difficult to load, and bulking is a straightforward, but messy, and time-consuming procedure.

3) Hose Length

Applying grease in tight places and small corners is challenging and necessitates the use of a flexible hose. As a result, most grease guns have an 18-inch flexible hose to appropriately apply or discharge grease on car or tool parts/components. Some grease gun types even have a greater hose length of roughly 27 to 42 inches. The length of the hose should be determined by the sort of equipment to be lubricated using these guns.

4) Leak

You don't want your grease gun to leak all over the place. Ideally, your grease gun should never leak. Most weapons, though, will leak at some time. Choose a grease gun that is wellmade enough to not leak most of the time. Of course, no firm will promote that its gun leaks. As a result, you must rely on evaluations like ours to determine whether or not a grease gun leaks. Cheaper, poorly-made guns are more prone to leak.

5) Ease of Use

A grease gun should not be difficult to use. These tools are simple and should be easy to use. Ideally, you should only have to aim and shoot! Some technologies, though, make it too difficult. We strongly advise you to select a grease gun that is incredibly simple to operate. Otherwise, you may experience difficulties, and tasks may become excessively frustrating.

6) Ergonomics

Because they weigh more, larger guns are less pleasant to handle in general. Smaller guns, on the other hand, are typically easier to use for a long time since they are lightweight. Simply said, you don't have to support as much weight.

7) Durability

The materials used to construct a grease gun determine its durability. The majority are constructed of steel. Steel grade, on the other hand, varies greatly. Some are quite tough and can withstand a pounding. Others will quickly deform and break. More expensive versions are often more durable. High-quality materials just cost more, hence the price rises.

You should not, however, assume that all pricey grease guns are durable. Some are both pricey and short-lived. It is critical to read evaluations in this circumstance since firms aren't always clear about the materials they use to make their guns.

8) Accuracy

When it comes to grease guns, accuracy and power are frequently at conflict. Those who are strong are not always as accurate. At the same time, individuals who aren't as powerful are frequently considerably more accurate. Some guns feature variable pressure, which allows you to balance accuracy and power. However, this is a somewhat uncommon characteristic. As a result, while purchasing the gun, you may have to choose between accuracy and power.

Accuracy is probably not as crucial as you believe. You can always clear up grease, for example.

The DEWALT 20V MAX Cordless Grease Gun features a built-in variable speed trigger that delivers on its promise of greater accuracy, even in small places, as well as a high-quality motor with a 10,000 max psi and the capacity to push out five ounces per minute. It contains a variable speed trigger for precise control of grease flow, as well as a flexible hose for accessing difficult-to-reach grease fittings. Another feature we liked was the cordless design, which made this the best battery grease gun we tried. The built-in LED light was also a standout component/feature that improved visibility.

Though we liked the cordless design and the option to use a number of external battery types, this is a large grease gun that weighs roughly 15 pounds, which might limit long-term use. Furthermore, the provided carrying case is constructed of plastic, which is less durable than steel and metal alloys. If you want to update your toolbox, choose the best toolbox liner as well.

The Lincoln 1162 Fully Automatic Pneumatic Grease Gun is an efficient tool, with an ergonomically designed rubber handle that is pleasant for long-term use and the ability to utilize bulk grease as well as pre-formed cartridges. We also like the variable speed trigger, which allows for optimum precision, and the accompanying 30-inch high-pressure hose, which we found useful for lubricating and greasing operations in difficult-to-reach regions.

The on-board motor has a maximum psi of 6,000, which is slightly lower than our top selections but still enough for most tasks. Furthermore, because this product has many small parts throughout its interior, we discovered that it needed to be cleaned on a regular basis to avoid clogging. This grease gun will make you want to purchase the best mechanic tool set as soon as possible.

This UTOOL Heavy Duty Grease Gun is made of high-quality materials, including a premium iron diecast head with better sealing properties and a strengthened O-ring to prevent leaks. We also liked how easy it was to clean, owing to the silver anode coating, and how the ergonomically built pistol handle, along with an exceptionally light form factor, enables for one-handed operation, unlike manual lever grease guns. This grease gun also has an automated improved exhaust valve that automatically drains air, eliminating the need for manual exhaustion when adding grease.
